# History

SPCS was established in August, 1997 by its founders Bishops Jon Pineda and Eva Pineda. They had a vision of fulfilling the Great Commission – to go and make disciples of men – through an institution that would provide quality education with a Christian perspective. They wanted the word of God to be accessible to as many young people as possible. Through prayer and great faith, SPCS was created. Many recommended that the school should start with just an elementary school to make the vision a little more affordable to the stakeholders.



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Bishop Pineda, however, knew that God would provide and make a way for the fulfillment of this ministry. The school opened its doors with one multi purpose building (Building A) for grades K3 to 12 with only 75 students enrolled. By the end of the first school year the enrollment doubled. In the fall of 1999, Building B was built and the school continued to grow. Recently, SPCS purchased five acres of land behind the current location and will break ground for construction in the school year 2016-2017, its 20th year.



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On this site will rise Building C – the new high school and sports recreational center, equipped to support all indoor sports including an indoor running track. The current gymnasium will be transformed into a state of the art theater. The expansion of the facilities will support the ever-expanding school population and ministry. The school is now the home to about six hundred students and almost a thousand alumni. SPCS has continued to prosper in academics, athletics, service, and citizenship. The students and graduates have continued to be a testament of God's faithfulness and favor to the SPCS Family.

## ACADEMIC OVERVIEW



St. Paul Christian School offers challenging, hands-on learning opportunities for its students. SPCS focuses on providing instruction that meets the needs of each individual student. It prepares students to be strong in all subjects and ultimately thrive in the outside world. It aims to nurture self-confidence and critical independent thinking. The atmosphere is conducive to learning in a stimulating yet encouraging environment.

- The SPCS Athletic Program provides a positive and inclusive atmosphere where students can grow emotionally, intellectually and physically.
- Locally, SPCS competes as a member of the Interscholastic Athletic Association of Guam (IIAAG) at the high school level. IIAAG is Guam's interscholastic athletic organization for public and private schools. It provides varsity level competitions year-round for various sports. SPCS competes in basketball, volleyball, soccer and rugby.

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- Moreover, SPCS is also a member of the Asia Christian Schools Conference (ACSC). The ACSC was established in 2013 to provide sports, ministry, cultural, and relational opportunities for students in Asia International Evangelical Christian high schools. The ACSC provides varsity level sports competitions for volleyball, basketball, soccer, and track & field.

1. **Education.** To enroll my child in the appropriate educational institutions, obtain access to my child's academic records, authorize my child's participation in school activities and make any and all other decisions related to my child's education.
2. **Travel.** To make travel arrangements on behalf of my child for destinations both inside and outside of the United States of America by air and/or ground transportation; to accompany my child on any such trips, and to make any and all related arrangements on behalf of my child including, but not limited to, hotel accommodations.
3. **Health Care.** To inspect and disclose any information relating to the physical and mental health of my child; to make any and all health care decisions; to sign documents, waivers and releases required by a hospital or physician; to authorize my child's admission to or discharge from any hospital or other medical care facility (including transfers to another facility); to consult with any provider of health care; to consent to the provision, withholding, modification or withdrawal of any health care procedure, and to make any and all other decisions related to my child's health care needs.

The Guardian may exercise any of these powers at any time that I am unavailable to exercise such authority. Any person may deal with the Guardian in full reliance that this power of Attorney and Designation of Temporary Guardian for Minor Child has not been revoked and that I am then unavailable to exercise the authority provided for herein, if the Guardian submits a written statement to that effect.
